Methodology

This training questionnaire was drawn up by staff from CVS Hounslow and the LBH as part of the NLDC programme 08-09.

Consultation as to how the questionnaire was to be distributed by email was conducted with Mike Veitch, the IT worker for the CVS's in Hillingdon, Hounslow and Ealing. Mike provided the IT programme by which the questionnaire was circulated and information was collated and produced.

The questionnaire was circulated electronically twice in December 08 and again in January 09 to all groups on the CVS email list. Paper copies were sent to those groups without email in December 08. This combination meant all 198 members were contacted. Each chart in this report answers each of the questions asked.

By 1st March 22 responses had been received representing a response rate of 11%. To increase this a member of CVSH staff telephoned all the members from whom questionnaires had not been received. By 20th March all groups had been contacted, and where appropriate the questionnaire was filled in over the telephone resulting in a total response rate of 48. This response rate of 24% is extremely high, when figures of 2-5% are generally expected.

The information collected has been analysed and forms the rest of this report.

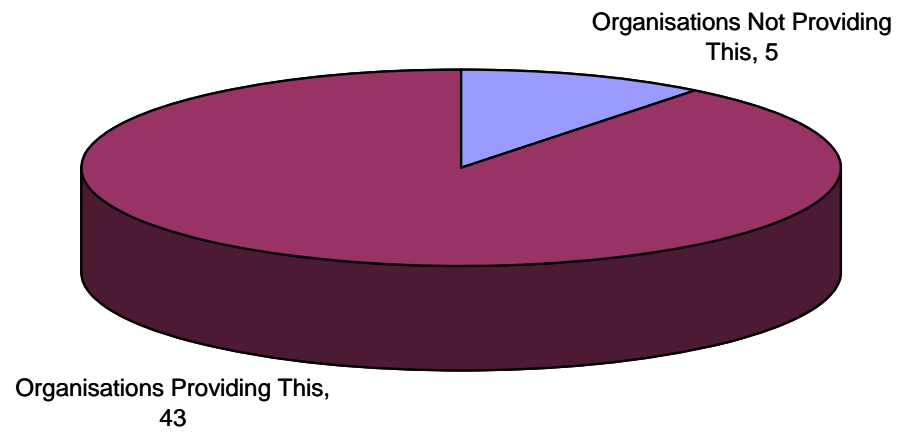
Appendix 1 details the organisations who completed the questionnaire

Brief Summary of Results

There were 48 responses submitted of which 31 describe themselves as providing training 29 of these 31 are using experienced/ qualified trainers and 21 organisations expect their trainers to gain job skills as a result of their training. Organisations expect their trainees to progress to volunteer work (21), accredited courses (17), further education (17), work experience (12) employment (13), or referral to an employer (8). 15 organisations provide course leading to an accreditation.

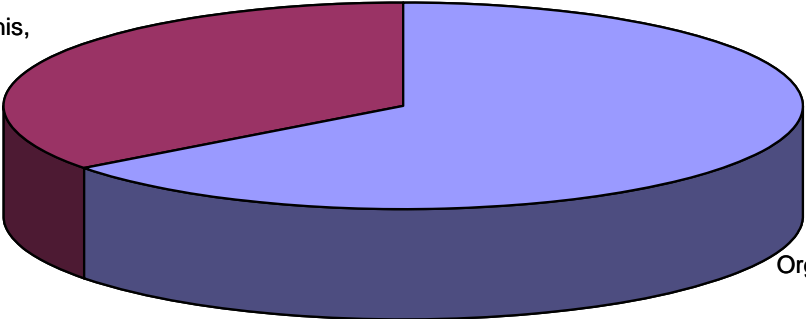

Our Premises Are Used as a Venue For Training by Adult Education



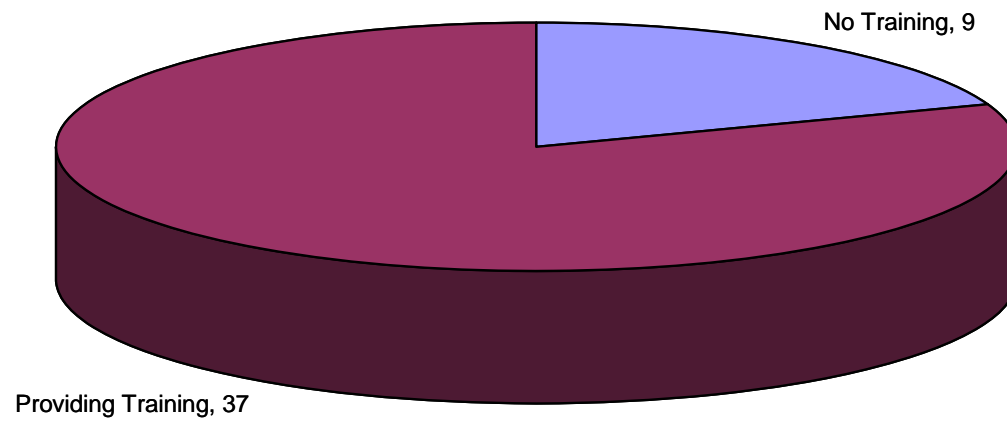
We Provide Our Own Classes and Training

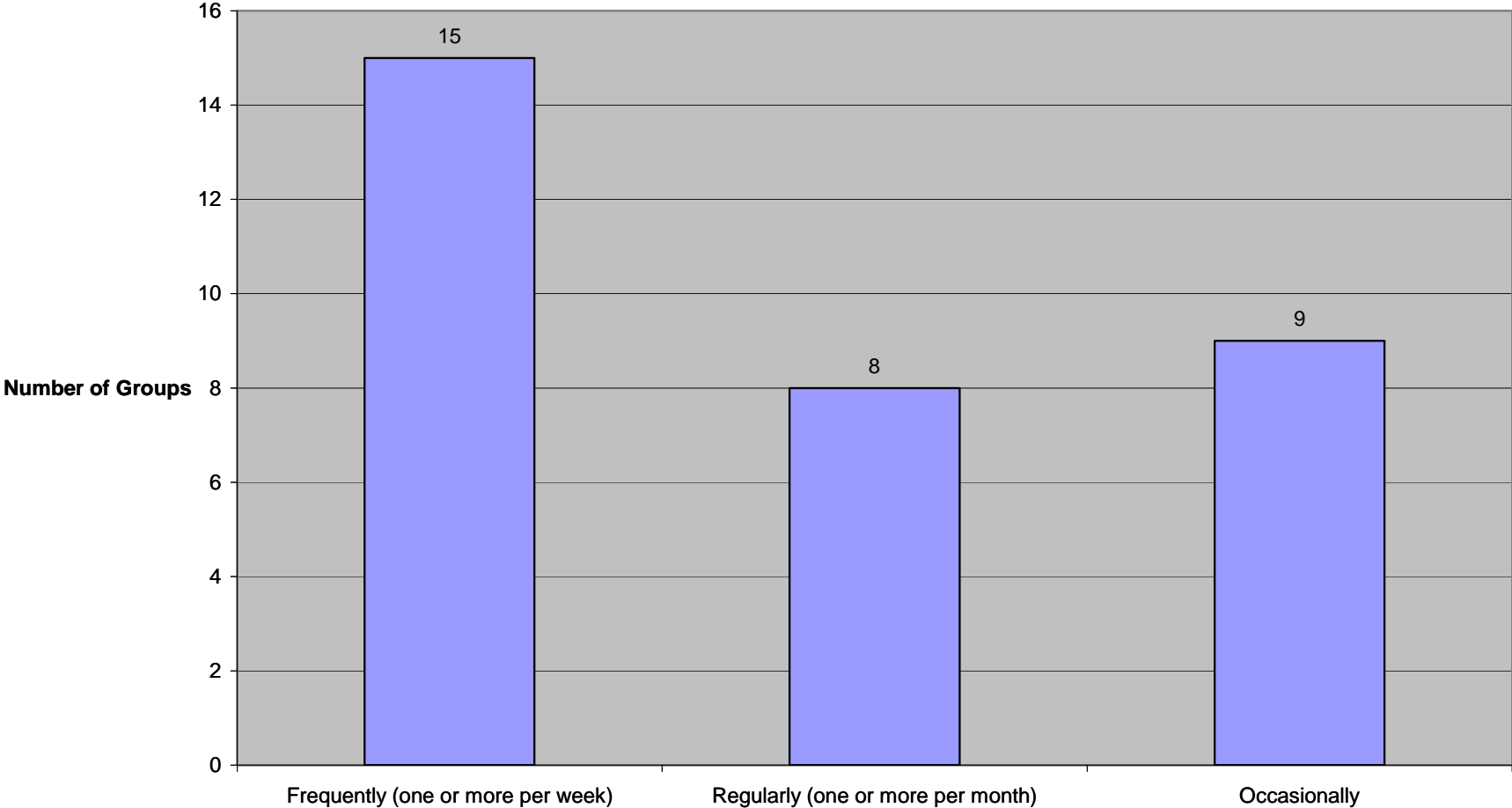

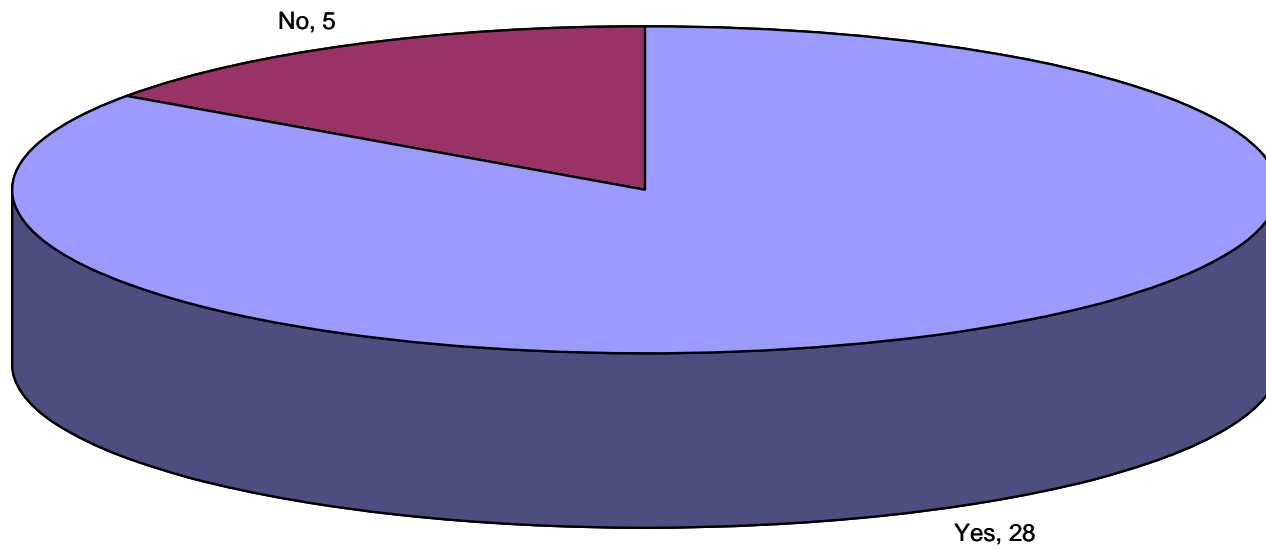
Organisations Not Providing Any Training



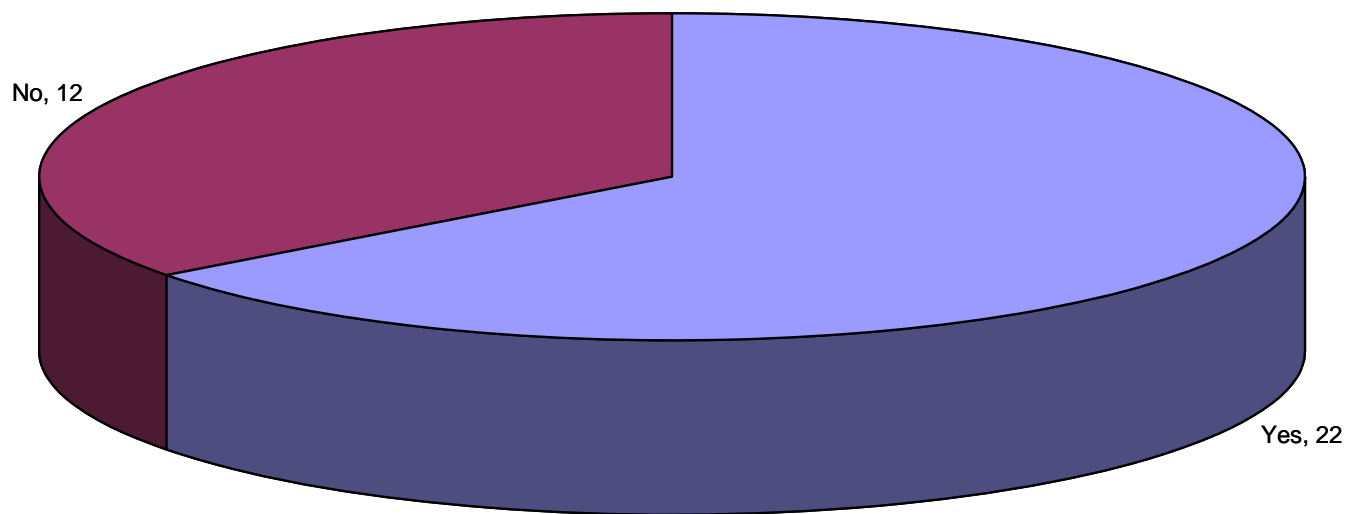
How Often Does Your Own Organisation Provide Classes or Training?



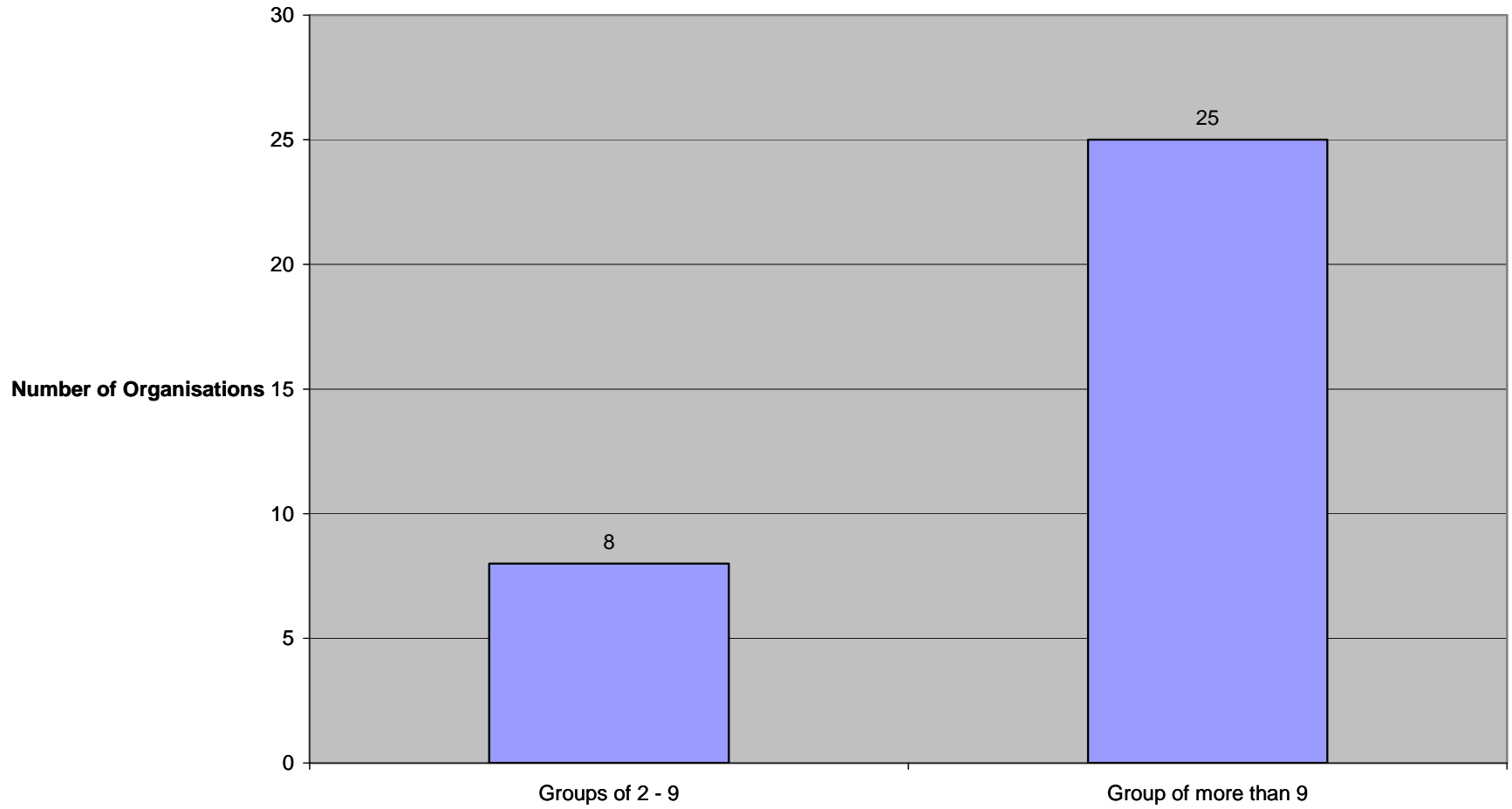
Organisations Providing Training at Their Own Address?



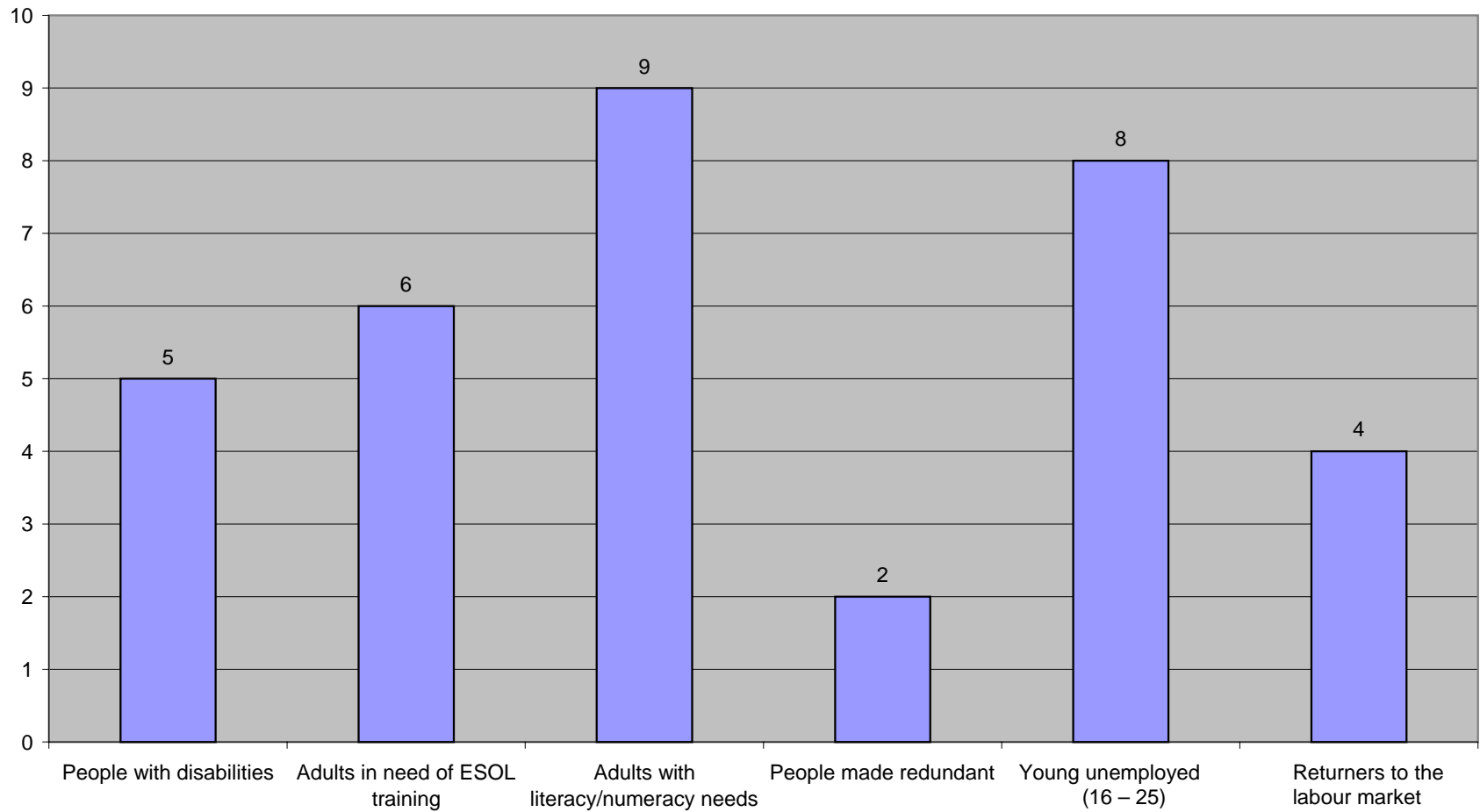
Organisations Providing Training at Other Venues?



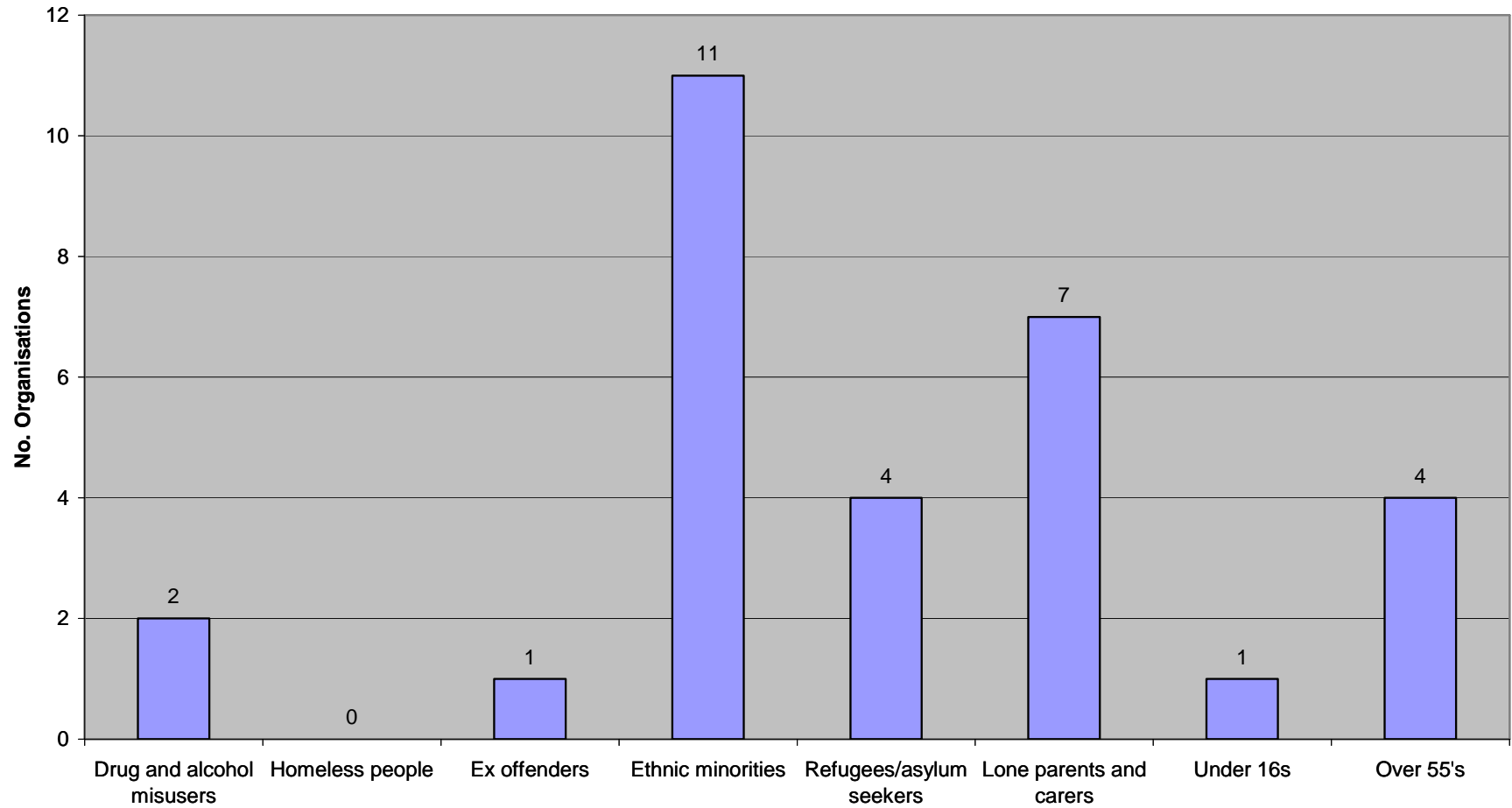
Average Size of Training Groups?



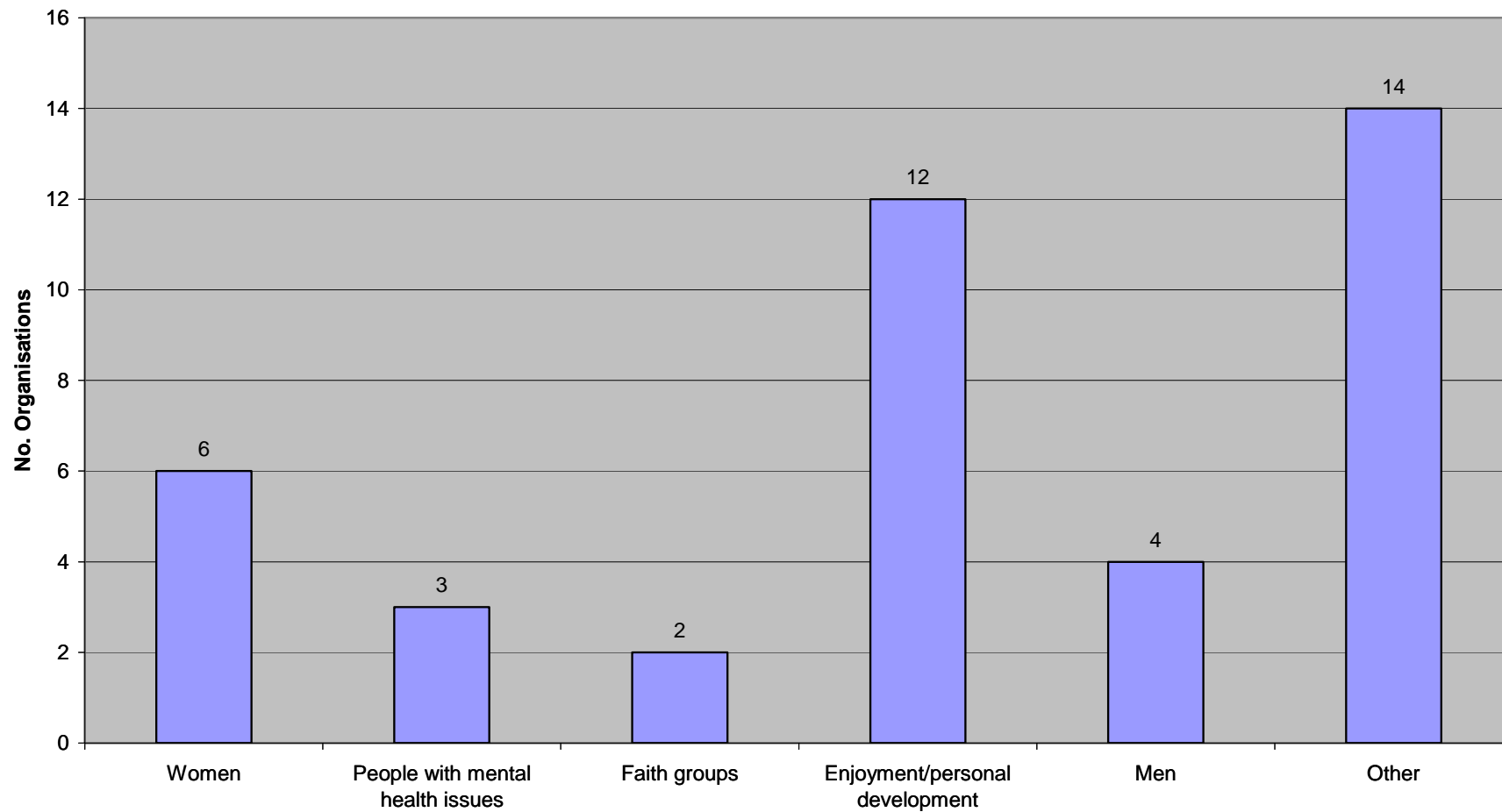
Number of Organisations Putting on Specific Training For



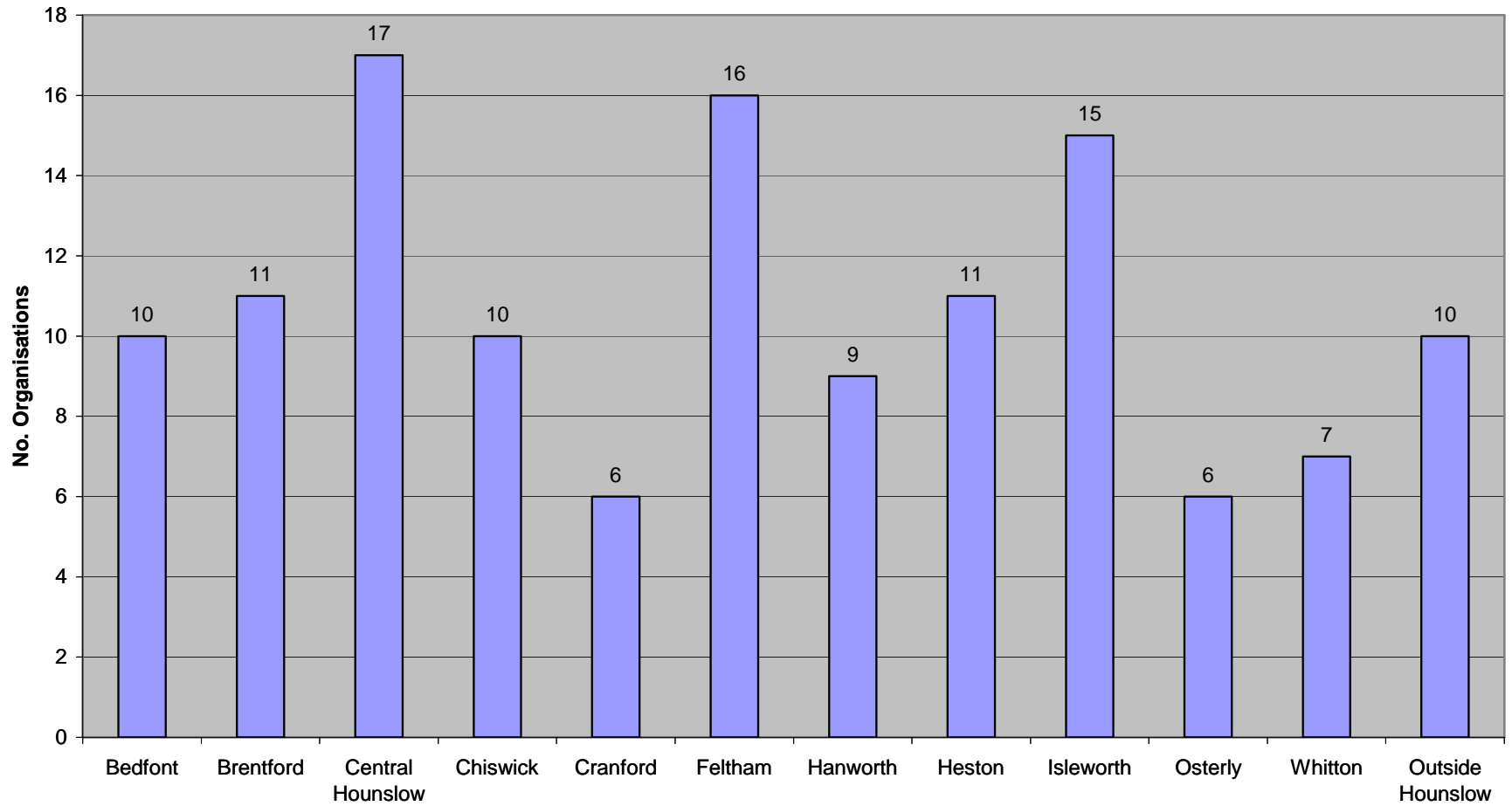

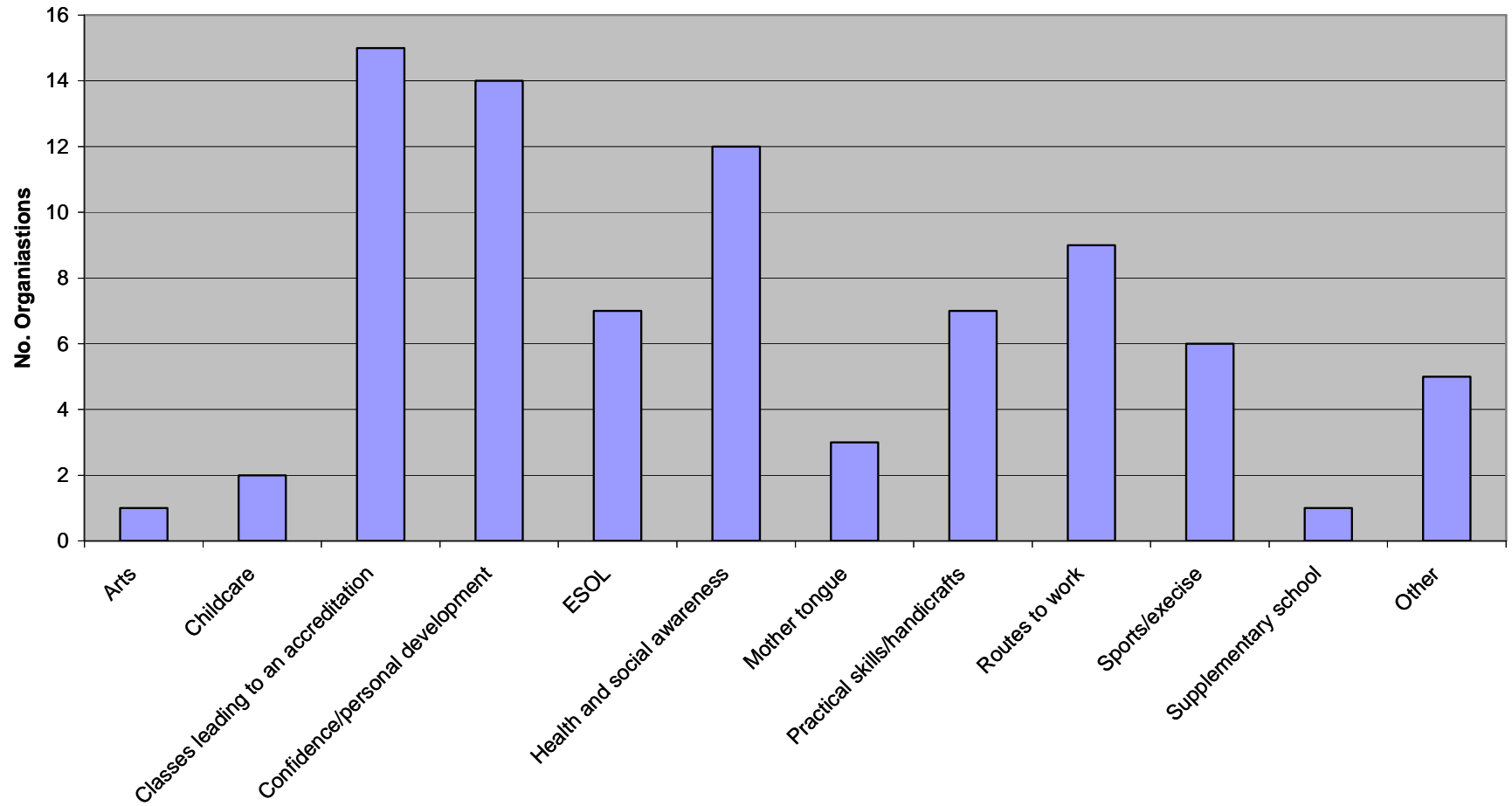
Number of Organisations Putting on Specific Training For...



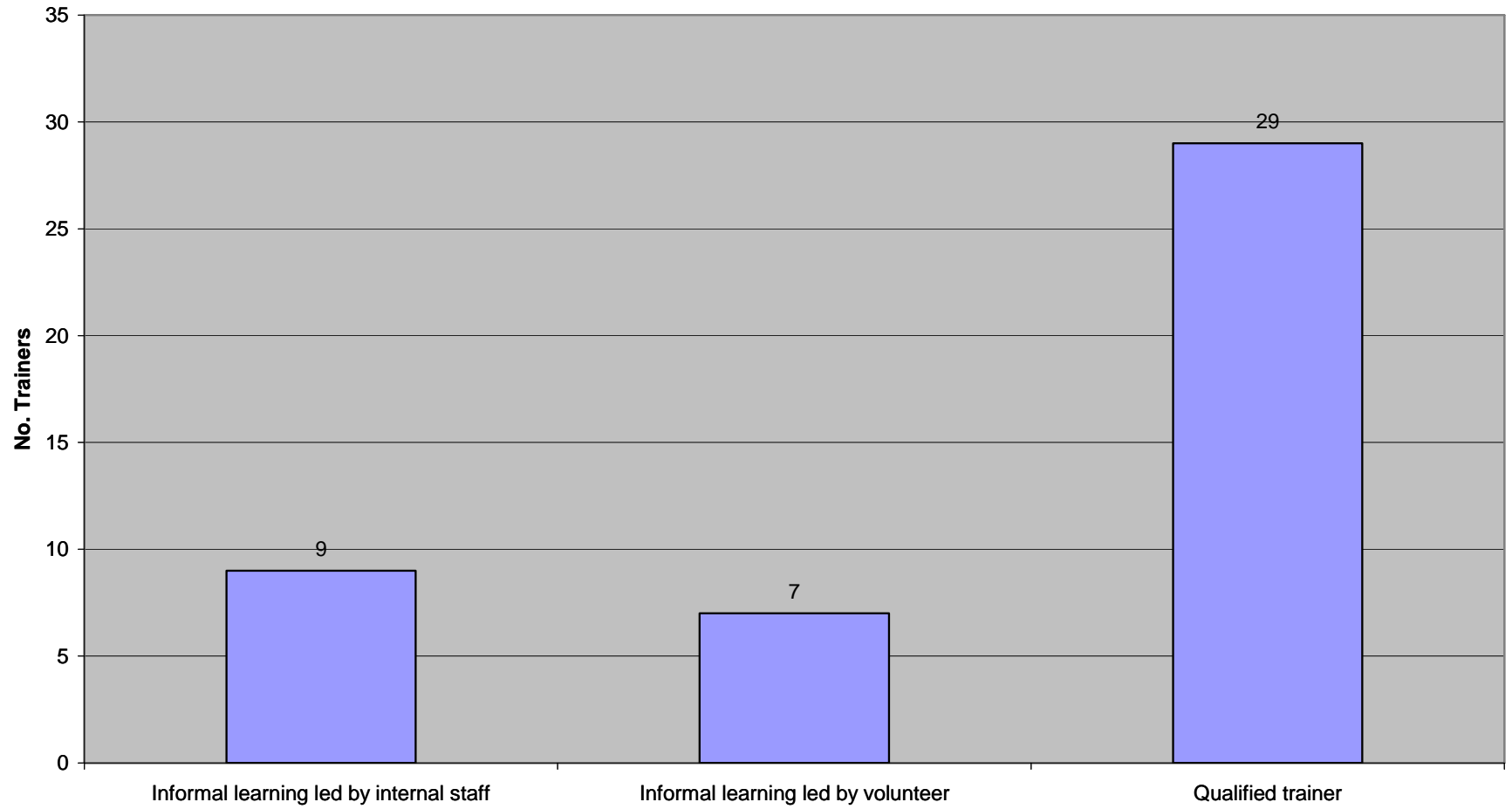
Areas Where Most of Organisations' Trainees Come From?



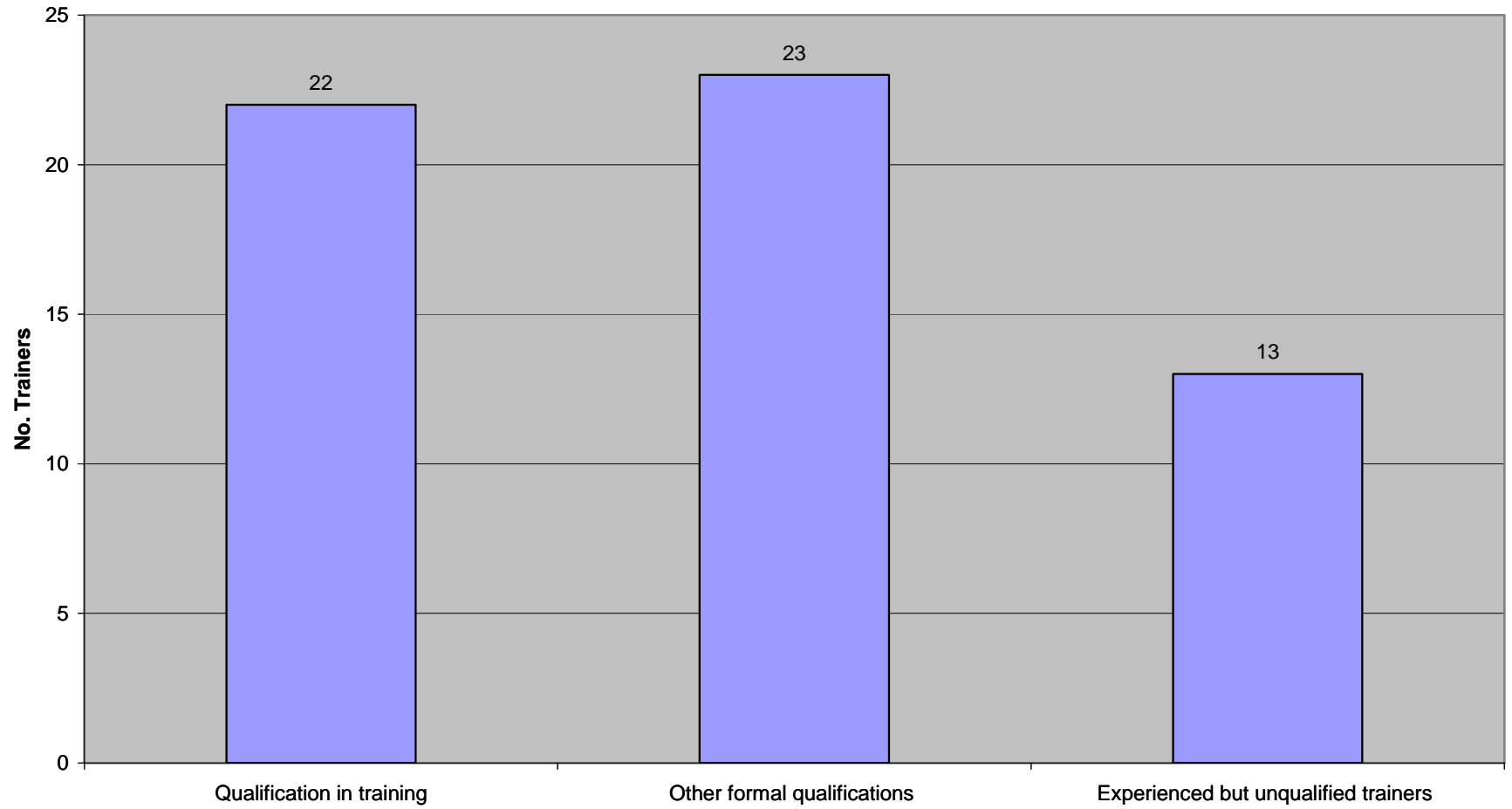
Number of Organisations Providing Training In...



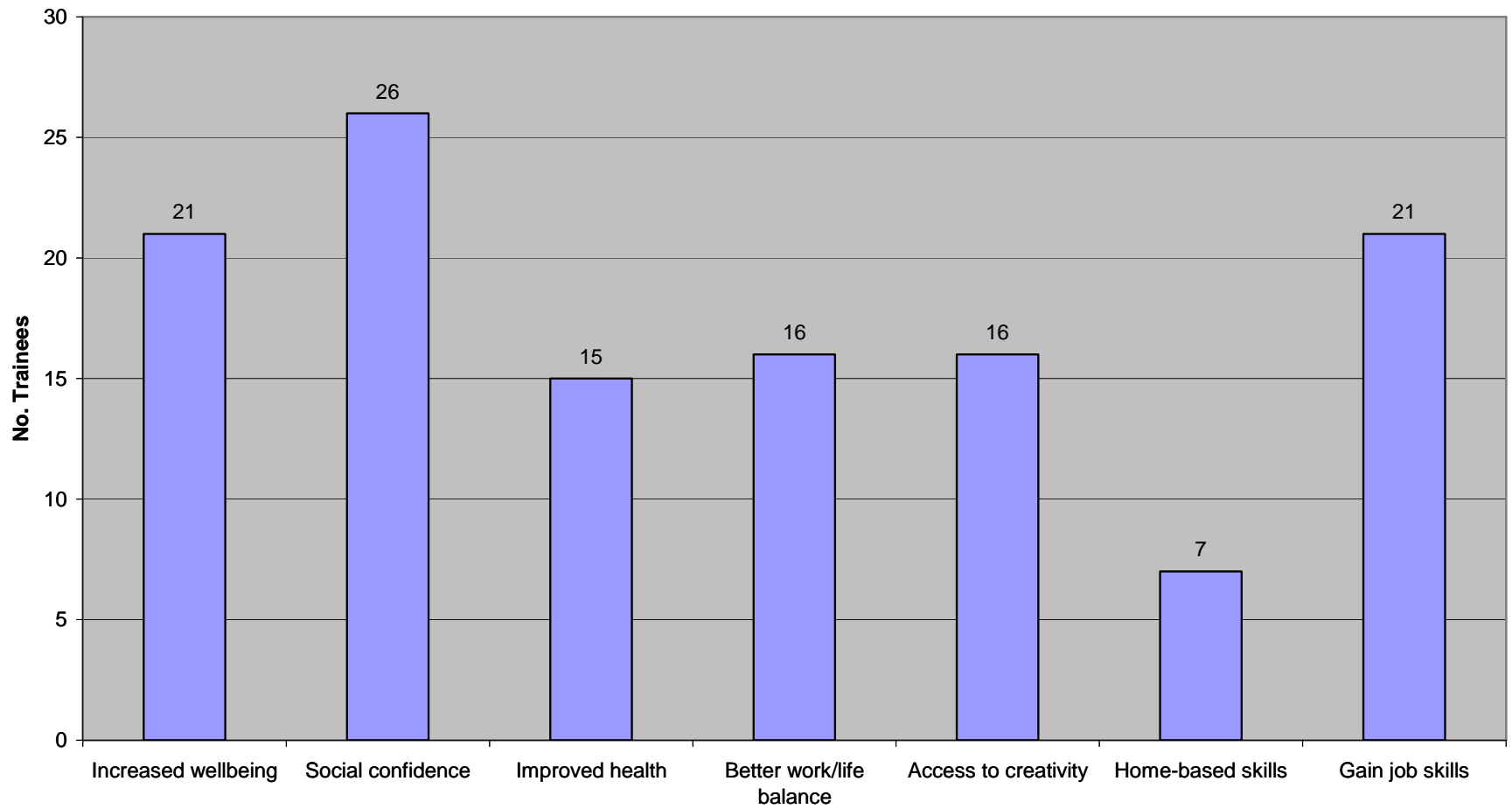
Who Leads the Training?



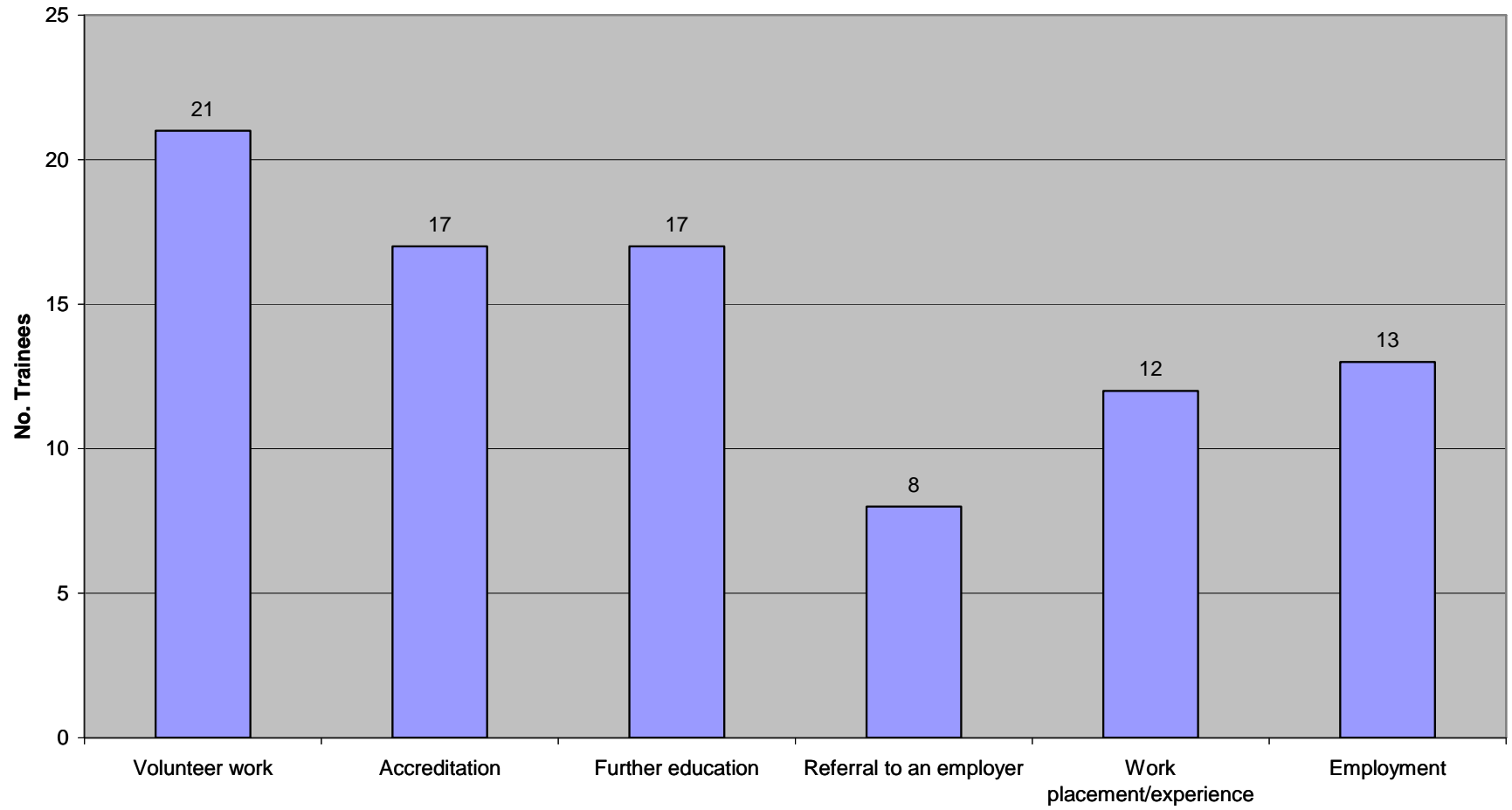
Trainer Qualification Levels
